## MEETING OF THE MIDDLE CLASS

This year the lengths from 18 to 30 metres dominate the scene more than ever before. Thanks to the diversity of models boot Düsseldorf is clearly attractive to first-time buyers!

Really Düsseldorf has everything. The diversity is remarkable, even without models from 40 metres upwards. Exercises in style, never seen before, present themselves in Düsseldorf. Anyone ordering an Arcadia can soon be sitting in his own greenhouse. The Italian yard from Naples is introducing

an extraordinary construction that on the one hand fulfils today's green requirements and on the other hand has a high recognition value. The glass superstructures offer a sliding roof, solar panels supply up to four kilowatts, and a waste water disposal system by Hamann goes without saying. Below the glass roof

Italian interior architecture and furnishings by the furniture craftsmen of Poltrona Frau dominate. The shipyards with conventional styling are working on the details. Princess presents the new 85 in its V-series that corresponds to the type of open boats from yards of the south. It already has a flybridge and is there-

fore heading for the top of a trend. The Sanlorenzo SL62 is similarly conservative in comparison with the Arcadia. But with a length of 18.90 metres she scores with an owner's cabin in front of the engine room that is huge in comparison with her overall size.
